
Notice of Availability of Initial Study, Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration, for the Reclamation District 817 Gibbs Pond and 40 Mile Road Pipe Repair Project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

Reclamation District 817 proposes to replace two gravity-flow pipes that provide storm drain and irrigation drainage through the northern levee of Dry Creek in Yuba County, California. The project is located approximately 1.5 miles northeast of the Sacramento River, and 2 miles west of State Route 99 in Sutter County.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Reclamation District 817 has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. The studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains the findings of the studies is the Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project. This notice is to advise you that the preparation of this report has been completed and is available for you to review.



WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

An Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for the proposed project and is available for public review beginning December 1 through December 31, 2021. Pending review of all public comments, the Reclamation District Board will consider a decision to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and, if so approved, direct staff to proceed with the Final Design of the proposed project.
