Project Title: Permit No. 19615 – Knights Landing Flood Management Project: Sacramento River, Mid-Valley Levee Reconstruction Sites 9 and 10.

Project Location/City/County: The project is located Sacramento River right bank levee would be conducted at Sites 9 and 10 between levee mile (LM) 2.66 and 3.22. The site boundaries include the levee prism to Yolo County Road (CR) 116B.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19615, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To reconstruct the levee crown and embankment along two sites on the right (west) bank of the Sacramento River near Knights Landing to address seepage. The through-seepage mitigation improvements include construction of two shallow cutoff walls along a total of 1,700 feet within the levee embankment.
