


Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration Study Results Available Changes Proposed for U.S. Route 395 in Mono County Opportunity for Public Hearing

What's Being Planned:

The California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) is considering the "Rock Creek Pavement" project to repair pavement on U.S. Highway 395 in Mono County from 0.5 mile south of Lower Rock Creek Road (postmile 9.8) to 1.3 miles south of Crowley Lake Drive overcrossing (postmile 12.6).

Why This Ad: CALTRANS has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why it is called an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the report, its availability for you to read and offer comments, and to notify you that an online public meeting will be offered upon request.
