PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located on Dry Creek Road approximately 0.8 miles west of its intersection with Mt. Veeder Road and spans over Dry Creek in an unincorporated rural area of Napa County, California within the AW – Agricultural Watershed zoning district. Adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 027-330-002, -010, -015, -017, & 027-530-003, -004.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Napa County (County), in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to replace the existing structurally deficient Dry Creek Road Bridge over Dry Creek in Napa County, California as part of the Highway Bridge Program (HBP). The new bridge would be constructed along a roughly east-west alignment located 150 feet south of the existing bridge in order to straighten the bridge approach and bypass the hairpin curve segment of Dry Creek Road. There would be no expansion in the number of travel lanes.
