DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Reduce and remove heavy vegetation in the transitional landscape surrounding Hearst Castle at Hearst San Simeon State Historical Monument to reduce the hazardous fuel loads and to improve emergency access, the project will:

- Use chainsaws to remove dead and/or diseased trees, as well as non-historic or non-native trees
- Chip and recycle or create burn piles for cut limbs or other small vegetation;
- Haul off the larger sections of the felled trees for either green waste disposal or a firewood program; and
- Use heavy machinery to complete minor grading to improve the existing fire road that was constructed during the Chimney Fire.

All work will comply with the US Migratory Bird Act, the California Public Resources Code, the California Coastal Act, and San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District regulations.
