Project Title: Knights Landing Ridge Cut Erosion Repair Project (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YOL-30145-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Knights Landing Ridge Cut in the County of Yolo, State of California; from 38.759922, -121.694364 to 38.748697, -121.693189.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-30145-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Knights Landing Ridge Drainage District, as represented by Meegan Nagy.

This project involves a phased series of levee erosion repairs. The existing levee slope will be cleared of grasses and bushy vegetation, without removing any root systems. Hydraulic excavators would be utilized at repair locations to remove and reshape existing soil and to place rock slope protection (RSP). Phase 1A will run approximately 2,200 feet long and 25 feet wide, while Phase 1B will run approximately 1,900 feet long and 25 feet wide.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
