Description of Activity:

The proposed action today is authorization to prepare a final design for the modifications and improvements to the two Earl Schmitt Filtration Plant 5MG tanks. The whole of the action also includes construction and operation of the project. The term "Project" in CEQA refers to the whole of the action and to the underlying activity being approved, not to each governmental approval. (CEQA Guideline §15378(a),(c),(d)).
