Project Location - Specific: The City of Porterville Skatepark is a 14,500-square-foot area located within Veterans Park (1501 W. Henderson Avenue; APN 251-350-001) on the east side of N. Newcomb Street approximately 700 feet south of W. Henderson Avenue,

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The Project consists of the addition of up to six solar lights, installation of a shade structure, installation of approximately 3,000 square feet of concrete to complete the interior components of the skating area, and installation of skateboarding elements (quarter pipe, ramps/gaps, long rail, etc.). All Project activities would occur within the existing Skatepark footprint.
