Project Title: Permit No. 19802- Broadband Initiative Project – State Route 198 at Kaweah River Bridge B. No # 46-0027 at PM 37.08

Project Applicant (if any): California Department of Technology

Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located on State Route 198 at 36.421232°N, 118.918134°W, crossing Bridge #46-0027 at South Fork Kaweah River, in the city of Three Rivers. (Designated Floodway, South Fork Kaweah River, Tulare County)

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To install three (3) 2-inch diameter Fiber Optic Conduit (FOC) with fiber optic cables crossing South Fork Kaweah (Bridge #46-0027). The FOC will be installed by trenching 2 feet to 6 feet deep (4.2 feet typical depth) on each end of the bridge and will be attached to the bridge deck overhang.

Exempt Status:

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The project is statutorily exempt under the provisions of CEQA. The Board’s approval involves issuing an encroachment permit for the installation of a Broadband Network Infrastructure on State Route 198 along the South Fork Kaweah River at Bridge No.44- 0027 which is exempt under the statutory exemption of the CEQA Public Resources Code Section 21080.51.

In addition, the Board has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA CCR, Title 14, Section 15303), because the activity consists of the installation of utility extensions. The project is also exempt under the Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land categorical exemption (CEQA CCR, Title 14, Section 15304), because the project involves minor public alterations in the condition of the land which does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA CCR, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
