



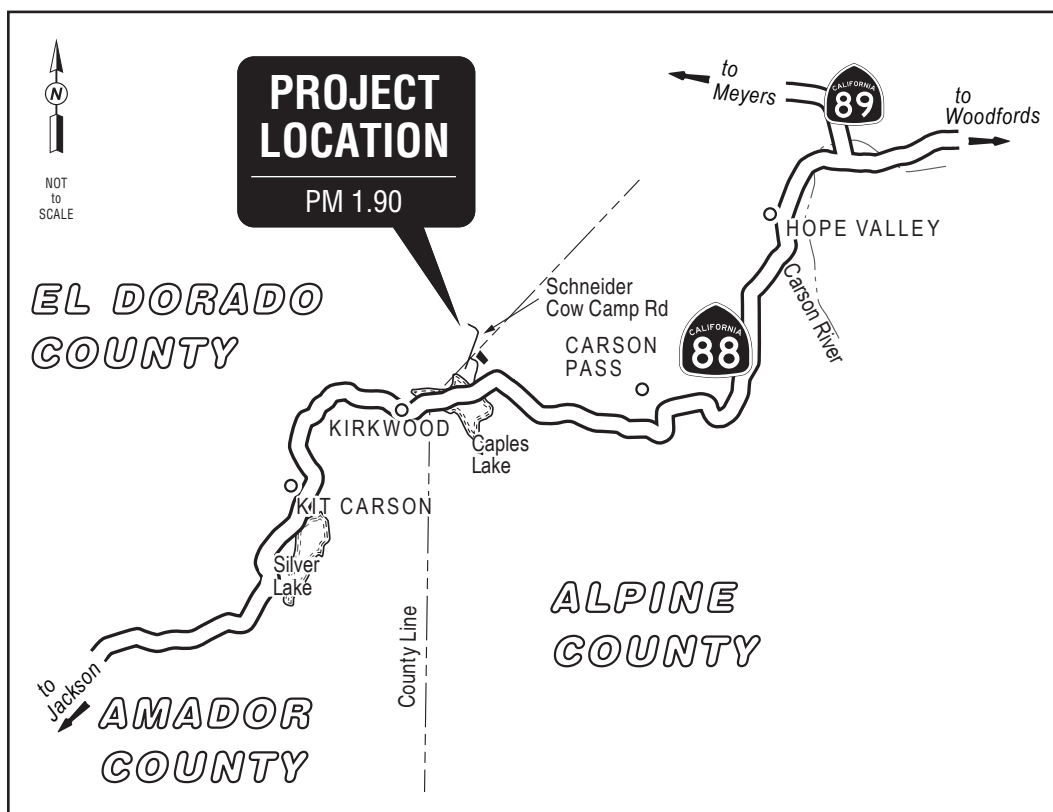

Do you want a public hearing on changes proposed along State Route 88 for the Caples Lake Maintenance Station Rehabilitation project?



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to rehabilitate structures at Caltrans' Caples Lake Maintenance Station along State Route 88 in Alpine County.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. This notice is to tell you of the availability of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration, which you can now read and comment on, and to offer the opportunity for a public hearing.
