

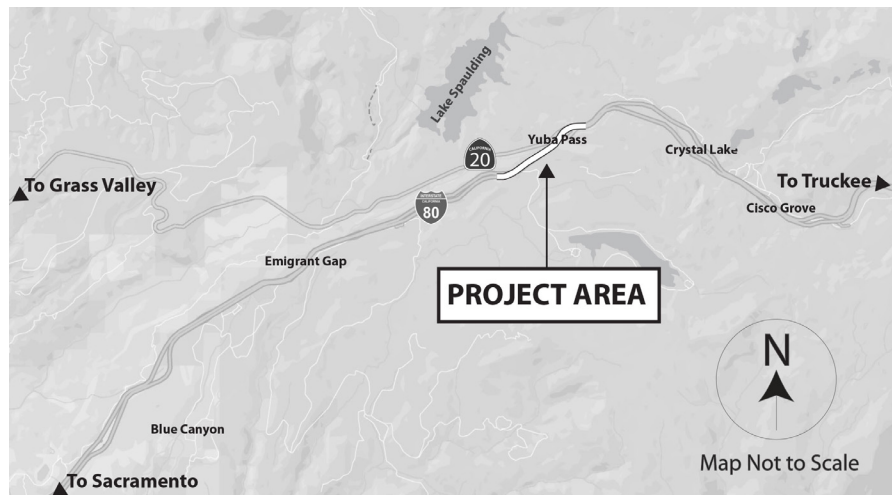


PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION OF THE YUBA PASS BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace and widen the Yuba Pass Separation Overhead (SOH) Bridges along I-80 in Nevada and Placer County. The proposed project would improve freight efficiency along I-80 by increasing the load carrying capacity and address the following structural deficiencies that necessitate the replacement of the structures: concrete cracking and spalling, high corrosive chloride content, superstructure repainting, work deck overlay, and bearing pad failure. The bridges are located in Nevada County 0.6 miles east of the Lake Valley Road Overcrossing Bridge and 4.6 miles west of the Cisco Overcrossing Bridge.
