




# PUBLIC NOTICE

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION OF THE SODA SPRINGS PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

### WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED:

The California Department of Transportation proposes to rehabilitate a portion of Interstate 80, in both Placer and Nevada Counties, from 0.2 miles west of the Troy Road undercrossing to 0.1 miles east of the Soda Springs overcrossing. This project proposes to repair distressed pavement and bridge deck on the existing eastbound (EB) and Westbound lanes and shoulders, construct an EB truck climbing lane and widen and replace the EB Troy Road (19-106R) and Kingvale (19-107R) undercrossing structures for the continuation of the truck climbing lane. Existing culverts will be repaired, replaced, or extended as needed. Detector loops on the mainline as well as existing overhead sign structures and sign panels will be replaced.
