Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

A Site Approval application to install a manure only digester and biogas facility on an 8.5-acre portion of a 444.68-acre parcel with an existing dairy, the Douma Dairy. The digester will process manure waste through a gas collection and water filtration system to convert greenhouse gases (GHG) to Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) and to convert filtration by-products to fertilizer. The proposed project includes a digester, gensets, boilers, backup/emergency flare, biogas upgrading equipment, and a 1,500 sq. ft. shop. The manure feeding the digester will be supplied by the onsite dairy and by an offsite dairy located 25.5 miles east of the project site. The Renewable Natural Gas produced will be trucked off site as will the separated solids from the project to be sold as fertilizer.

SJCOG responded to this project referral that the project is subject to the SJMSCP. The applicant has confirmed that he will participate in SJMSCP.
