**Project Title:** Black Oak Mountain (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. MEN-20329-R1)

**Project Location:** The project is located at unnamed tributaries to Tenmile Creek, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; 52000 North Highway 101, Laytonville, CA 95454; or Assessor’s Parcel Number (APN) 013-510-48-00.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number MEN-20329-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Gabriel Barragan.

The projects are limited to the removal and replacement of 5 culverts, the installation of 3 new culverts, the decommissioning and revegetation of two low-water ford crossings, and the on-stream domestic diversion using the natural spring on the property.
