**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. MEN-22610-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Kevin Bush.

The projects are limited to the new construction of a bridge crossing along Woodman Creek, the removal and replacement of one culvert, and the on-stream diversion from Woodman Creek.
