**Project Title:** Issuance of a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement for the Template Safe Harbor Agreement for Conservation of Coho Salmon in the Shasta River and the associated Site Plan Agreement for Emmerson Investments, Hole in the Ground Ranch. Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0402-R1

**Project Location (include county):** Shasta River and Parks Creek, Siskiyou County

**Project Description:** The Project is the issuance of a Streambed Alteration Agreement (SAA) for Emmerson Investment's Shasta Springs Ranch located in the Parks Creek basin, which manages land and water for livestock, hay production, and fisheries and wildlife habitat. The project activities covered in the SAA agreement include land and water management for Routine Agricultural Activities including operation and maintenance of surface water diversions, maintaining stream crossings and cattle watering lanes, and implementing Beneficial Management Activities (instream habitat restoration, fish passage improvement, riparian enhancement, tailwater control, water efficiency, diversion coordination, diversion and screen upgrades, and implementing avoidance and minimization measures).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency, approved the above described project on October 25, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
