DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project will install an iconic sign atop the existing California State Railroad Museum roof to bring attention to and promote attention to the Old Sacramento business district which includes Old Sacramento State Historic Park.

Work will:

- Mount an approximately 20-ft tall x 32-ft wide steel frame structure on the existing California State Railroad Museum roof;
- Use bolts/fasteners to establish connections that comply with structural stability requirements;
- Install lighting that is set to direct night illumination in the direction of Interstate Highway 5.

All work will be done in accordance with the Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation of Historic Structures.
