


## Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration Study Results Available Changes Proposed for U.S. Route 395 (Virtual) Public Meeting to be Held February 15, 2022 (6:30 pm – 8:00 pm)

## What's Being Planned:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is considering the "Lee Vining Rehab" project, which proposes to rehabilitate pavement, replace sidewalks and guardrail, add or replace drainage facilities, and perform other work on U.S. Route 395, from postmiles 50.6 to 53.10 in and near the community of Lee Vining in Mono County, CA.

Why This Ad: Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study, Proposed Negative Declaration. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the report, its availability for you to read and offer comments, and to notify you that an online public meeting will be offered.
