Project Title: Silver Peak Solar Project (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2022-042-06 Minor Amendment No. 1 (ITP))

Project Location: The Project is located in southwest San Bernardino County, California, in the City of Adelanto. The Project is directly west of Interstate 395, at latitude 34°36'27" north and longitude 117°26'25" west, bordered by Calleja Road to the north, El Mirage Road to the south, Astern Road and US 395 to the east, and Juan's Road to the west.

Project Description: The Project involves a minor amendment to Condition of Approval 8 in the original ITP to allow the Permittee an additional 12 months to complete the compensatory mitigation requirement.

The amendment to the ITP will not increase the impacts or mitigation as stated in the original ITP.
