

Do you want a public hearing on changes proposed for State Route 145 in Madera?

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from February 9, 2022 to March 11, 2022.

If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing to replace distressed pavement, update existing facilities, install Complete Streets features, and implement a "Road Diet" (reducing the number of lanes from four to two from E Street to Fig Street and adding a two-way left-turn lane in the center of the roadway and Class II bike lanes on both sides of the roadway) on State Route 145 in the City of Madera in Madera County between Avenue 13 and the BNSF Railway underpass.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Negative Declaration. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
