The Proposed Project would construct a bicycle/multi-use trail undercrossing for the existing Santa Gertrudis Creek Trail. The existing trail crosses Margarita Road in the City of Temecula, which is a heavily traveled four-lane divided collector roadway. The proposed undercrossing would improve safety at this location by removing the need for existing at-grade roadway crossing for the trail. The Proposed Project consists of a total of approximately 610 feet of a shared bicycle/trail undercrossing, which would begin where the existing grade of the Santa Gertrudis Creek Trail ramps begin to elevate to meet the grade of the overcrossing of Margarita Road at the east and west sides.
