

# CEQA Environmental Document Filing Fees

CDFW imposes and collects an environmental document filing fee to defray the costs of managing and protecting California's vast fish and wildlife resources, including, but not limited to, consulting with other public agencies, reviewing environmental documents, recommending mitigation measures, and developing monitoring programs.

## Annual Adjustments

CDFW is required to adjust the environmental document filing fees annually ([Fish & G. Code, § 713](#)). The annual fee adjustments are based on changes in the Implicit Price Deflator for State and Local Government Purchases of Goods and Services, as published by the U.S. Department of Commerce. The adjusted environmental document filing fee amounts are posted on CDFW's website prior to November 1 of the year before they become effective January 1.
