<u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u>

The purpose of the Project is to prevent road damage and disruption to traffic due to drainage system failures by rehabilitating or replacing the existing pumping plant (Location 2; SJ-4-PM R16.1). Project construction activities involve horizontal directional drilling under Mormon Slough to install electrical conduit. Approximately 525 feet of 2-inch or 3-inch conduit will be installed at least 4 feet, but not more than 6 feet, below the bottom of the canal without interfering with the water or canal wall. Boring pits of roughly 4-feet by 10-feet at each end of the conduit run will be needed for the conduit installation. The total Project area is approximately 2.35 acres.
