Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project consists of the demolition of all existing on-site development and construction of a new industrial and warehouse building on the project site. The proposed new building would include approximately 8,000 square feet of office space and approximately 118,700 square feet of warehouse space, for a total area of approximately 126,700 square feet. The height of the building would vary between approximately 36 feet up to 43 feet and 8 inches, consistent with height allowances within the current site zoning of Industrial Park (IP). The building would be constructed to allow for or accommodate installation of rooftop solar panels. The project would include 79 parking spaces and 27 stalls for trailer parking. Vehicle access to the surface parking lot would be provided via the existing driveway on Concourse Drive. An internal circulation road would circle the building, connecting the driveway, parking area, and trailer parking stalls. Additionally, internal circulation would allow access to a loading dock area proposed on the north side of the building.

Mitigation Measure (MM) BIO-1: requires construction activities be scheduled to avoid the nesting season (Feb 1-Aug 31) or alternatively conduct a pre-construction survery for nesting birds

MM CUL-1.1: requires a qualified archaeologist shall prepare an Archaeological Monitoring Work Plan

MM CUL-1.2: requires a qualified archaeologist and Native American consultant shall conduct archaeological and Native American monitoring of all project-related ground disturbing activities and if resources are found, work within 50 ft must immediately halt

MM HAZ-1: requires a soil samples be taken at the site to determine if contaminants from previous agricultural operations occur at concentrations above established construction worker safety and commercial/industrial standard environmental screening levels and if contaminated soils are found the applicant shall obtain regulatory oversight from the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health

MM HAZ-2: if required by MM HAZ-1, a Site Management Plan shall be developed

MM TRA-1: requires the applicant to provide a rideshare program and commute trip reduction marketing/education

MM TRA-2: requires the applicant to provide a Transportation Demand Management Plan
