Project Title: May Pier Rebuild Boatlift (Lake Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0368-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located on Lake Tahoe in El Dorado County at Lat. 39.028272° North, Longitude 120.119141° West.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0368-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Robert and Judith May.

The amendment to the existing Agreement, previously issued to the project Applicant, consists of the retirement (removal) of a mooring buoy and anchor block from the bed of Lake Tahoe and installation of a boat lift on the replacement pier described and permitted in the original Agreement. The installation of the boatlift will require driving an I-Beam support piling into the lakebed adjacent to the pier. This will result in 0.14 square feet of permanent impact to the lakebed.
