Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Sierra Nevada Conservancy will provide grant funding to the Eastern Sierra Council of Governments for preparation of a regional trails plan, the Eastern Sierra Towns to Trails Plan ("Trails Plan").
