Project Location: The project is located within the right-of-way at the intersection of West Point Loma Boulevard and Nimitz Boulevard.

Project Description: The project will install an approximately 30-foot-long segment of 18-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) storm drain and a new 5-foot by 5-foot curb inlet. This project will use the open trench method of construction. Trenches are typically 3 to 4 feet wide and 5 to 7 feet deep and are dug with excavators and similar large construction equipment. All trenching work would occur entirely within the developed right-of-way. An existing traffic signal conduit and loop detectors will be relocated. Any roadway impacted by trenching will be resurfaced.

Project Location: The project is located in the intersection of West Point Loma Boulevard and Nimitz Boulevard (east side), San Diego, CA. All proposed work will be located within the City's right-of-way

Brief Project Description: The proposed Capital Improvement Project would install an approximately 30-foot long segment of 18-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) storm drain and new 5-foot long by 5-foot curb long inlet. The storm drain trench would be at a depth of 5 - 7 feet and width of 3-4 feet, and would occur entirely within the developed right of way (ROW). An existing traffic signal conduit and loop detectors will be relocated. Any roadway impacted by trenching will be resurfaced.

Determination: Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee. This determination does not in any way imply that the project is exempt from CEQA and does not determine the significance of any potential project effects evaluated pursuant to CEQA.


