



CITY OF MILPITAS NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Milpitas has completed an Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS-MND) for the proposed City of Milpitas Trail, Pedestrian, and Bicycle Master Plan in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act.

Project Proponent: City of Milpitas Engineering Department, 455 East Calaveras Boulevard, Milpitas, California 95035

Project Description: The proposed City of Milpitas Trail, Pedestrian, and Bicycle Master Plan is intended to increase walking and biking in the city of Milpitas through the provision and enhancement of safe and convenient active modes of travel. Proposed bicycle improvements include a bicycle network that would connect residential roadways with paved shared use paths, protected crossings, and improved bikeways to support bicycle travel throughout Milpitas. Proposed improvements to the trail network include expanding existing paths along creek corridors and adjacent to major roadways to support a connected trail system.

Project Location: Citywide

Findings: The following environmental factors have been identified as having a potentially significant impact before mitigation: Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology & Soils, Hazards & Hazardous Materials, Noise, Recreation, Tribal Cultural Resources, and Mandatory Findings of Significance. All other impacts in the categories were found to be less than significant.
