Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0040-R2 ("Deer Creek Park" Nonindustrial Timber Management Plan (NTMP) 2-19NTMP-00012-NEV, Terra Alta Development Co).


Project Location: The projects are located within Little Deer Creek and its tributaries, in Nevada County, State of California. The projects are located on the North Bloomfield and Chicago Park U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quad Map, Township 16N, Range 9E, Sections 8, 9, 15, 16, and 17, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The projects are limited to the use of a water drafting site (map point WD1), the installation of two permanent culverts (map points X3, X4), the removal of an existing Humboldt crossing and replacement with a temporary plastic culvert (map point X5), and the installation of a temporary Spittler (map point S1).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration / timber harvesting plan prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
