

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has prepared an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND) for the State Route (SR) 37 Capital Preventive Maintenance Pavement Project in Marin County.



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

Caltrans proposes to preserve and extend the life of the existing pavement on approximately 14 lane miles (3.4 linear miles) of SR 37 from the Ignacio overhead crossing (U.S. Highway 101 junction) to the Petaluma River Bridge at the Marin/Sonoma County line. The Project includes resurfacing and repairing the existing asphalt-concrete pavement; settlement correction; replacing traffic loop detectors; upgrading concrete barriers, guard rails, and curb ramps; installing enhanced visibility striping; adjusting and cleaning drain inlets; and providing vegetation control under guardrails and thrie-beam barriers.

WHY THIS AD

Caltrans, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), has prepared an IS/ND to analyze potential effects the proposed project may have on the environment. This notice is to inform you of the public comment period.
