

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHO: Project Applicant, Sonoma County Department of Transportation and Public Works

WHAT: The Sonoma County Department of Transportation Public Works proposes to replace the existing bridge on Geysers Road over Frasier Creek, east of Cloverdale CA. The existing bridge will be replaced with a single span concrete box girder bridge that will be 32 feet wide. The new bridge will on the same alignment as the existing. Traffic on Geysers Road will be conveyed over a one-land temporary bridge located slightly up stream throughout construction. The project will occur on county owned right of way. **Supervisorial District 4.**

Parcel Zoning: The project will take place within the County owned Right-of-Way. Surrounding parcels are zoned Resources and Rural Development.

In accordance with Public Resource Code and CEQA Guidelines, the County of Sonoma provides notice to agencies and interested parties that it is releasing a final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the project. The IS/MND did not find potential environmental impacts that could not be mitigated to a less-than-significant level. The IS/MND is available at Permit Sonoma at 2550 Ventura Avenue, Santa Rosa, CA 95403.

WHERE & WHEN:

After the close of the IS/MND public review period, it is anticipated that the IS/MND will be adopted without a public hearing on, June 14, 2022, unless a written objection is received by the Director prior to that date. If a written objection is received, a public hearing will be scheduled and a notice of the hearing will be issued.

All comments received after the review period will be included in the public record for consideration and provided to the decision-making body prior to or at the public hearing scheduled as above.

If you challenge the decision on the project in court you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to Permit Sonoma at or prior to the public hearing.
