Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration for the Rehab 52 Culverts Project on State Route 169 near Weitchpec

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing a project on State Route 169 between postmile 15.0 and postmile 33.8 in Humboldt County. The project would rehabilitate 52 existing culverts that are in poor and fair condition and improve drainage on a vital rural link on the Yurok Reservation.

The CEQA environmental document, referred to as a draft Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND), for this project will be available for review from April 13, 2022 to May 12, 2022 at the following locations:
