**Project Location/City/County:** The project is located in the City and County of Sacramento, California, along the left bank (when facing downstream) of the Sacramento River. The proposed project includes Sacramento River erosion protection work near Miller Park and in the Little Pocket and Pocket-Greenhaven neighborhoods.

**Project Description** The proposed project consists of approximately 14,950 linear feet of bank protection and approximately 3 acres of planting benches along the Sacramento River east levee. The Sacramento River Erosion Contract 2 is the second contract on the Sacramento River and is anticipated to be constructed in 2023 and 2024 to address longstanding erosion concerns along the Sacramento River east levee.
