Title: American River Watershed Common Features, Water Resources Development Act of 2016 Project, Sacramento River Erosion Contract 2

Applicant: Central Valley Flood Protection Board

Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, along the Sacramento River east levee between Front Street and the Pocket-Greenhaven neighborhood, from River Mile (RM) 49 to 59, near Sacramento, Sacramento County


Description: The Project includes construction and use of erosion protection, including launchable rock toe protection, rock tie-backs, planting benches, and soil-filled rock slope protection. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through December 16, 2044.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on December 17, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An  Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB), certified an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) on June 9, 2016. On October 28, 2022, the CVFPB certified a Supplemental EIR and MMRP. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIRs as certified for this project and has adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating CVFPB's documents. The EIR, Supplemental EIR, and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
