Project Title: Yuba-Beale Levee Repair (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YUB-24724-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Best Slough, in the County of Yuba, State of California; Latitude 39.054654, Longitude -121.444088; Assessor's Parcel Number 015-070-074-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YUB-24724-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, AgIS Capital.

This project is limited to the repair of 80 linear feet of levee that was breached during the 2018-2019 wet season. The levee will be repaired to its prior size, approximately 15 feet wide and 15 feet tall.
