Project Title: King City Capital Preventative Maintenance Project (Notification No. EPIMS-MON-44564-R4)


Project Location: The Project is located on United States Highway (US) 101 at highway post mile (PM) 45.17 and PM 43.65, near the community of King City, in Monterey County, California. The Project involves work at two locations, one within Thompson’s Gulch, a tributary to the Salinas River and one within an unnamed tributary to the Salinas River.

Project Description: The Project includes replacing two failing drainage culverts, creating new drainage outlet structures, and placing rock slope protection. The Project is part of a larger overall project which includes improving the highway pavement and making additional highway facility improvements to maintain the roadbed and improve the ride quality on US 101.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on June 29, 2022, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
