The proposed project would provide increased public safety benefits by rehabilitating and improving flood management infrastructure to achieve a 200-year Urban Level of Protection for the Mossdale Tract area. The Mossdale Tract area includes RD 17 (16,110 acres), portions the Cities of Stockton, Lathrop, Manteca, and unincorporated San Joaquin County. The proposed project would include the construction and operation of flood risk reduction and multi-benefit components in and adjacent to the Mossdale Tract area. The flood risk reduction components are fix in place and potential setback levee improvements and the multi-benefit components are ecosystem restoration and recreational features.
