DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project will repair a large foundation crack and associated damages at Residence #31, located at 22786 Broadway St. in Columbia State Historic Park, to protect the historic structure from further damage. Work will:

- Use same, or in-kind mortar to reset the displaced or loose brick and rock;
- Use color-matched mortar to repair a damaged window frame;
- Inject Type "N" mortar or, approved equal, into the crack as deeply as possible from both the basement side and exterior side; and
- Refinish the crack face with mortar that color-matches the mortar used to repair the displaced stonework.
