PROJECT TITLE: Sugar Pine Point Campground Flagpole

LOCATION: Ed Z'berg Sugar Pine State Park **COUNTY:** El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install an aluminum flagpole at the entrance station to Ed Z'berg Sugar Pine Point State Park to display the United States and California State flags. Work will:

- Use a shovel to hand excavate a 30-inch deep by 20-inch diameter hole;
- Place an approx. 28-foot tall flagpole in the hole and backfill excavation with concrete, weed-free sand and road base to secure; and
- Spread excavated soils around the worksite and blend to existing soil level.
