DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project will perform geotechnical investigations for the replacement of facilities damaged by the 2018 Woolsey Fire across Leo Carrillo State Park. The investigations will evaluate the subsurface conditions at the locations where facilities will be rebuilt. Rebuilt facilities include, but are not limited to, staff residences, offices, storage, maintenance facilities, campgrounds, restrooms and a beach access staircase. The investigations include exploratory borings and in-situ infiltration tests. Boring locations will be backfilled and left in as close to their original condition as possible.
