Project Title: Camino Del Mar Bridge Replacement Project

Project Description: The San Diego Water Board issued a Clean Water Act section 401 water quality certification (Certification No. R9-2024-0125) to the Project Applicant. The Project activity entails the removal and replacement of an existing bridge (No. 57C-0209) with a new bridge as well as the north and south existing connections to the Camino Del Mar roadway. The new bridge design consists of a five-span cast-in-place pre-stressed concrete box girder bridge that would be slightly longer, wider, and higher than the existing bridge; however, the number of piers in the river mouth supporting the bridge will be reduced from ten to four

This is to advise that the San Diego Water Board, a Responsible Agency, has approved the above-described project on November 1, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project.

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
