Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located approximately 350 feet southwest of the West Essex Street and Barrymore Street intersection in the City of Stockton, at 37.983700°N, 121.308600°W, San Joaquin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Calaveras River, San Joaquin County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To remove approximately 460 feet of ornamental fencing from the Calaveras River levee toe and reinstate the encroachment 15 feet from the landside levee toe.
