Project Location (include county): United States Highway (US) 101, from postmile (PM) 7.8 to PM 16.5, in San Luis Obispo County.

Project Description: Improve assets in poor condition to ensure the long-term serviceability of US 101, between Nipomo and the City of Pismo Beach. Asphalt concrete overlay will be placed on US 101 within most of the project limits. Other assets included in this project are culvert improvements, bikeway striping, adding maintenance vehicle pullouts, paving beyond the gore area, fence replacement, vegetation control, slope paving, installing median concrete barriers, bridge rail replacement, bridge deck sealing, bridge approach slabs, and updating the curb ramps to current Americans with Disabilities Act standards, in San Luis Obispo County.
