Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Improvements to the Hiram Johnson High School sports fields including stadium lighting, restrooms, renovation of the softball/hardball diamonds, golf practice area and related hardscape and landscape improvements. Permanent lights will replace the temporary stadium lights currently used.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The Negative Declaration determined that the project could potentially impact traffic and pedestrian safety during the occasional maximum stadium event (such as a popular Homecoming Game). Event Traffic Management mitigation measures are included to address this issue.

Although unlikely it is possible that artifacts could be discovered on the site during grading and shallow trenching required to refurbish/re-seed the ball fields and replace the hardscape. Mitigation Measures are included to address unanticipated discovery of tribal artifacts.

The project will not generate construction period or operational emissions in excess of air quality thresholds however, the document includes the Air District's Dust Control rules to reduce fugitive and nuisance dust in close proximity to residents.
