**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY/NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT
DRAFT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTO UNIFIED
SCHOOL DISTRICT'S**

HIRAM JOHNSON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FIELD IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT: The Sacramento City Unified School District (District) has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the improvements of the athletic fields at Hiram Johnson High School located at 6879 14th Ave, Sacramento, CA. The proposed project would include installation of permanent stadium lighting at the existing stadium; the addition of restrooms and a concessions stand to serve the athletic areas; replace the bleachers in the stadium area; grade and re-seed the turf in the ballfields and other improvements such as new dug outs, fencing and catch nets, and the development of a golf practice area. The District intends to adopt the MND at their June 16, 2022, Board of Education meeting.

SUMMARY: The MND found that the project would have a less-than-significant effect on the environment with incorporation of mitigation measures. The document reviewed light and glare, air quality and greenhouse gases, traffic, cultural and tribal resources, hydrology, and other aspects of the environment. The MND includes mitigation measures to reduce any anticipated impacts to a less-than-significant level.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: The Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) will be available for public review and comment from May 11, 2022, to June 9, 2022. It is expected that the District Board of Education will act on this project on or after June 16, 2022.
