**Reasons Why Project is Exempt:**

Class 1 allows for the rehabilitation of deteriorated or damaged facilities to meet current standards of public health and safety, and for the repair and maintenance of existing public structures, facilities, mechanical equipment where it involves no or negligible expansion of use. Building #255 (M4) is part of the Napa State Hospital, an historic era facility which has been evaluated for eligibility for listing as a historic resource and reviewed by the State Historic Preservation Office. The State has confirmed that Building 255 is not part of an historic district, nor is it eligible as an historic resource. No exceptions to the exemption apply.
