<u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u>

The purpose of the Project is to continue Pacific Power's fire mitigation program of electrical system hardening in California, and all activities are being conducted in accordance with California Senate Bill 901 and the new provisions of California Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 8386. Pacific Power is planning maintenance activities on approximately 3.09 miles (696 linear feet or 0.13 mile in wetlands) of their existing 12.5-kilovolt overhead distribution lines within the City of Mount Shasta and the surrounding area. The maintenance activities include replacement (i.e., reconductoring) of the entire line with covered conductors (i.e., wires), pole replacement, and updating system protection and other equipment as needed. Existing wooden poles will be replaced with fiberglass poles.

Exempt Status:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Article 19, section 15301, Existing Facilities. Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination.
