Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	<p>The purpose of this project is to replace approximately 11,700 feet total of aged pipelines within the City of Jurupa Valley, California.</p> <p>The pipeline replacement project entails the following improvements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Rutile Street: Replace approximately 3,905 linear feet of 8-inch diameter waterline to be replaced by 12-inch diameter PVC water line. Replace approximately 1,338 feet of 6-inch VCP sewer with 8" PVC sewer. Lining of approximately 653 linear feet of existing 8" sewer line.</li> <li>2. Steve Avenue: Approximately 812 linear feet of 6-inch diameter waterline to be replaced by 8-inch diameter PVC water line.</li> </ol>

	<p>3. 53<sup>rd</sup> Street: Approximately 1,351 feet of 6-inch diameter waterline to be replaced by 8-inch diameter PVC waterline. Replace 1,231 linear feet of 6-inch VCP with 8-inch PVC sewer line.</p> <p>4. 56<sup>th</sup> Street: Approximately 1,758 linear feet of 6-inch diameter water to be replaced by 8-inch diameter PVC waterline. Replace 1,304 linear feet of 6-inch VCP with 8-inch PVC sewer line.</p> <p>The project consists of trenching, backfill and compaction work to facilitate the replacement of existing sewer and water pipelines and appurtenant structures and connections to the existing sewer system. Restoration of surfaces to their original condition will be performed as well as protection and support of existing above and below grade facilities and utilities. The existing pipes will be abandoned in place.</p> <p>Beneficiaries of the project are Jurupa Community Service District customers, which include residential and commercial uses.</p>

	<p>approximately 3,922 linear feet of 8-inch waterline, approximately 3,873 linear feet of 8-inch sewer pipelines and lining of approximately 653 linear feet of 8-inch diameter sewer pipelines within the same public rights-of-way and easements.</p> <p>The Class 2 Categorical Exemption is for the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced, including but not limited to replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity. (CEQA Guidelines §15302(c))</p>





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



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
