### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project proposes to lease an existing 3,200± square foot building in Hayfork, California. The property consists of 2.5± acres and contains one structure, an outbuilding, and a paved parking area. Improvements to the building include interior walls, two showers, and plumbing. Exterior improvements include a hose rack, a temporary apparatus bay, and the installation of a radio communication system. As part of exterior improvements, a 4-inch rock base will be laid and two conex boxes will be placed onsite (40 ft by 10 ft). No ground disturbance will occur in association with these exterior improvements.
