Project Title: Tentative Tract Map 17916 (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2021-025-06 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): The Project is located on the Southwest corner of Mojave Street and Topaz Avenue, within the City of Hesperia, San Bernadino County. The Project site is approximately 40 acres, located on Assessor Parcel Numbers 0405-261-15, 16, 17, 18, 27, 28, 29 & 30.

**IV. Project Description:**

Project Description: The Project includes the development of 40 acres of undeveloped land into a single-family residential subdivision consisting of 177 single-family homes and paved streets. The Project involves road construction of 2 arterial roadways. In addition, the Project will include the construction of sidewalks, landscaping, underground utilities (water, gas, electric, sewer, CATV), street lighting, and a temporary western Joshua tree stockpiling area.

The Project will result in impacts to 28 acres of western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*) habitat. The Project will permanently remove 28 acres of western Joshua tree habitat. The project is expected to result in incidental take of western Joshua tree which is/are designated as a candidate species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
